Dear All,

Maggie and I have just had a wonderful weekend in Perpignan on the south coast of France.

Antoinette and Robert Heris are the senior pastors and they have two other couples pastoring with them, both coming from the UK. (Moray & Ann McKay and Doug and Erika Rogers) In fact, Ann came from the same small town in the north of England where I was born! We had a lot in common!

Antoinette had been given a prophetic word 10 years ago that she had a Deborah call on her life and then she heard about Deborah Arise through a friend in Paris. The vision began to be birthed in Antoinette's heart.

As you know, Beryl van den Hogan had been leading Deborah Arise in France for around 8 years, working mainly in the North. In October last year she shared with us how hard it had been to spread the vision in France and she had felt like giving up. God then spoke to her about the fact that HE would raise up women with leadership gifts in the different towns and cities of France who would be able to facilitate the vision of Deborah and all she needed to do was pray. This has been happening. Anyway, you can imagine how I felt when I met Antoinette. Here was a lady that God had raised up, living in the South of France. Let's pray that more ladies will emerge in many cities and regions of France, fulfilling the word of the Lord.

We started the Conference with praise and worship. Four women led the worship and the last song was particularly anointed "Let Your Glory fall in this room" and when we sang the words "Let it go forth from here to the nations" I sobbed and felt that God was saying that the vision of Deborah would expand from that place and even touch other nations.

The women seemed eager to catch the sword and run with the vision.

Antoinette was speaking about setting up many groups in that region.

During one of our meal times, Erika's husband was telling us of meetings they had attended where the presence of God was so powerful that they spent most of the time laying on the floor. We felt the presence of God around the dinner table as he shared with us how he had seen an angel when he was on his way to one of these meetings. Apparently this angel told them to hurry. Erika told her husband to put his foot down and do as the angel had said. We laughed as he told us that he had said in reply, "I cannot, as I will run the Angel over"!! It was awesome!

We need to pray for Erika who will be seeing a Consultant in England within the next week or so about a problem with her bladder.

At the beginning of April I went with my daughter, Sharon, and friend Sue, to Bulgaria, to do a ladies Conference. We all took part in this and the ladies were very blessed. I did two sessions on the Saturday morning, giving the Deborah vision, and it was so well received. Even before we came away, the women told me that they had taken up the sword in prayer and were already fighting for their children. We met a lovely pastors wife from the gypsy church who told me the same thing. I was so encouraged. On the Sunday morning we did a healing service and we saw people healed. Our Angels were on duty on our way to the church from the Airport. It was late at night, very dark, wet and foggy. We hit a bad patch of road and swerved off to the right, nearly

falling into a very deep ditch. Two men in a van drew up, tied a rope to our car and theirs and managed to pull us to safety. This was in the early hours of the morning - in the middle of nowhere!! We felt grateful to God for this deliverance - we asked the men if they were angels!!!

We so enjoyed being with these lovely people. We have had contact with this church in the north of Bulgaria for a couple of years now, and at this moment, young people from our Bible School are doing a mission there. I am sure they would appreciate your prayers.

As you know we had a Regional meeting in Salford, UK in March. We have recently heard from the leader of the group, Sandra Armstrong, saying that her son Matthew, who is in his early 20's, has been diagnosed with Hodgkins lymphoma (a cancer of the lymph glands). They have seen the consultant and she has just written to tell us the good news that it is treatable and has been caught very early. He will have to have 6 doses of chemotherapy and 1 course of radiotherapy. Please can we pray for him for complete healing and also for the family. Pray that Matthew and also his sister will return to Jesus at this time.

Sandra also shared that she had a picture of the prodigals. She saw their faces which are now turned towards Him not their backs. However, they have anguished faces and some will stumble and fall on the way back. Some were a long way off. Unfortunately she did not recognise any of them but knew that they were all coming back.

Please pray for a regional meeting planned for 9th May in the West Midlands, (UK) We had a day of planning with them and we sensed the presence of the Holy Spirit amongst us. I am sure we are going to have a good time together. Pastor Ruth Mwangalwa, our leader in Uganda will be holding a conference for Widows from 11th-16th May. Many of you will already know that as well as leading Deborah in Africa she leads the Widows Intercessory Network. They will be dedicating the 15th of May to Deborah Arise. Please pray for them during the whole of the conference as they gather together to pray for their nation and the young people.

What a wonderful treat it was to have my Granddaughter and Great-Grandson here in the UK. She lives in California. They stayed for three weeks. Trace is only 18 months old, and he was talking and keeping us amused for hours. They are so interesting at that age. We had such lovely times together with the whole family. Talking about family, Brian and I are going to Brighton tomorrow to look after Ruth's two teenagers whilst Ruth and Mark are on holiday. Please pray that we will have a great time with them, and that I will have many opportunities to pray over them and their rooms - without them knowing, of course!
