NEWS FROM JUNE

I have just returned from a prayer conference in Goiania, in Brazil. It was called "Touch the Fire for the Final Harvest". It has been an amazing experience. My faith has been built up to see what God will do in response to prayer. We saw how intercession, neighbourhood prayer, all-night prayer and spiritual warfare has changed the city. 7 years ago only 7% of the population were evangelicals in Goiania - now it has grown to 45%. I saw Christian government officials present the "KEY OF THE CITY" to the two ladies who run the Intercessors Network Centre in Goiania, Elizabeth Cornelio and Elizabeth Albemaz. These ladies have a half-hour radio programme, which is heard by 200,000 people every day. This is not Christian radio!! Prayer has become a passion over there, and the results are remarkable. (Although I was nervous at the thought of

participating in this programme, I thoroughly enjoyed the experience!)

Whilst I was in Goiania I saw gold dust that people have seen even in this country. In fact I have some on the pages of my Bible! The childlike faith of these people is so refreshing. Do I want to come down to earth now I am back in the UK? Certainly not. I want to experience more and more the presence of the Lord in whatever way he chooses to come. One night in the hotel, I dreamt that I was learning to fly!! It was a wonderful feeling! I pray that God will take us all to new heights of faith as we trust in Him.

NEWS FROM OUR CHURCH - KING'S WAY

Sixteen of our teenagers attended Soul Survivor in August, surrounded by thousands of other young people. Two young people in the group became Christians. Another seven re-committed their lives to Jesus with a new passion. On the fourth day, as they worshipped God, the Holy Spirit fell and almost the whole group were huddled together- weeping, hugging and praying for one another. On the final morning it was great to hear dozens and dozens of testimonies from young people who received salvation, healing, passion, inner healing, spiritual gifts and callings from God during Soul Survivor.

Another two of our young people, who have been struggling with their Christian faith, have received such blessing this summer. Susie (15 years old) said to me yesterday "I can't get enough of Jesus!". James (19 years old) has had a character change as he is experiencing more of God in his life.

Seeing young people being touched by God is wonderful. Let's continue to FAST and PRAY for them that these and others hold on to what He has done in their lives and use it to bless others everywhere they go. We have God who is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or even think!

the speaker began to talk about spiritual children who should be in Gods Kingdom whom Satan had or was trying to abort; children of Christian parents, backsliders and 'baby' Christians. The dream came

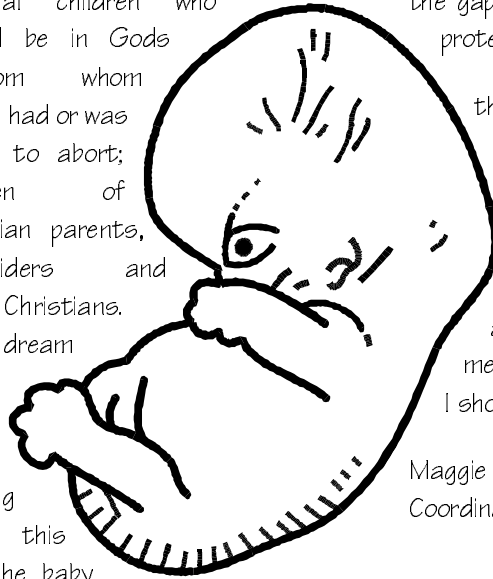
flooding back; this was the baby who was crying for help! The only way to help these spiritual children from being

- Praise God - M2K have reached their first target of 100 partner churches across the Greater Manchester region. The overall target is for 200 churches capable of hosting M2K events, actioning social projects, giving financially and praying fervently. Pray for these next 100 churches to come on board. Pray particularly for Bury, Tameside & Macclesfield, where local churches have been slower to pick up the vision. Irene from Towyn was praying for the intercessors, thinking of the powerful prayer warriors in the Holy Spirit's anointing and other intercessors, not so strong, even weak, but all needed. She then had the impression of a wheel, all needed, all united in the wheel and moving, actually moving.

She then remembered the wheel in the Bible (Ezekiel 1 and Ezekiel 10) and as she read the chapters it seemed that there was, or could be a comparison. The wheels only moved because the Spirit of the living creatures was within them. (Today we have the Holy Spirit moving us). The wheels were covered with eyes so also were the cherubim. The Holy Spirit opens our eyes to understand what is going on around us.

Someone else had a vision after they had seen the Deborah Arise Leaflet-

She had a vision that she saw gangs of youths on street corners, and like so many other people, she thought



they were up to no good, but when God took her closer, she couldn't believe what she saw- they were ministering to other young kids, no hoppers, kids with drug problems, bad attitudes, abused children, and they were putting hope into other young kids, they were talking about God and Jesus. There was a light in one lad's eyes, and that light was saying yes there is hope out there. But she felt that God was saying to see this there was work to be done first and that is for us to pray and intercede for the kids of today! GOD IS MOVING IN EDINBURGH!

During the summer holidays we received a report from Heidi Campbell, a student in Edinburgh, giving a 'street level' view of what God was doing amongst the students in Edinburgh. With her permission we share with you some of the things she wrote.

God is doing some neat things here in Scotland and is starting to really stir up students with a burden to intercede for their friends, universities and the nation.

God is just moving in people's hearts to seek his face and people are saying to me and each other "hey let's get together and pray". Nobody is telling them to do it, no church or leaders are organising these things, its just God.

I love to see the young men entering into travail for their friends, to hear how God is waking young people up in the night to pray for people or situations and to see the passion on their face and in their voices as the students gather to pray and praise.

All this is happening within different independent groups of students as well as stuff God is doing amongst the University CUs in prayer. One specific group I have been involved with has been meeting together for prayer the past 6 months in small settings (between 3-6 people) and have held three co-operate worship and intercession events for students (with about 50-100 people at each event!). We're all learning together about intercession and God is doing neat stuff in the process of teaching us.

God is moving and calling a new generation to the walls!

We were so excited by this news and June contacted Heidi to

let her know about Deborah Arise Europe. Towards the end of August Heidi contacted June with more information.

Several of us Students have been praying and brain storming about where God wants to take us this year. The worship and prayer events we hold are called 'Firestarter'. Colin Hewitt a 3rd year student from Northern Ireland is the visionary behind this

The group has four prayer requests:

- That God would release finances and resources necessary to run the events.
- Wisdom for Colin that he would clearly hear God's heart for where 'Firestarter' should go.
- That God would release more students (especially Scottish students) into a greater freedom and passion for Christ and desire to intercede for their generation.
- That God would raise up a group of mentors (especially women) to guide and support many of the younger students and Christians.

So lets pray for them folks and for all the universities in our land. Heidi is herself a product of an intercessor-praying Mum!!

MULTIPLICATION

Whilst in Brazil, June had the word 'multiplication' prayed over her and it was confirmed on two separate occasions. Currently we have 130 intercessors praying with us, we have people praying all over the UK, in Africa, Austria and Romania.

Please pray that this number will multiply and we will see the multiplication of answered prayer and a multiplication of young people having a growing personal relationship with Jesus Amen!
